SUBMISSION TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

By completing the online submission form, all authors understand and agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

- Accepted submissions will be scheduled by NADD, and at least one author is expected to be available to attend and present at the conference.
- Primary presenters receive a \$100 discount on the conference registration fee. Secondary presenters will be responsible for full registration fees.
- By submitting an abstract you give consent for the publication of the abstract and author's details in all conference material including (but not limited to) conference website, blog posts, newsletters, social media and conference app.
- Presentations slide decks will be collected and provided electronically to conference delegates on request.

- **Presenters must remain unbiased at all times. They may reflect on personal experience as it pertains to their topic and material, but it is expected that they will refrain from expressing any personal/political views.**

- Presentation Synopsis*** - One-page maximum; can be either in outline or paragraph form but must include 1-3 annotated references.
- Topic Area** - Please choose one topic from the list on previous page that best applies to your proposal.
- Audio-Visual Requirements** - You will be asked to identify what you will need from the following:
 - Podium with One Microphone
 - Flip Chart with Markers
 - LCD Projector with Screen - presenters must bring their own laptops
 - Audio for video clips
- Two Educational Objectives** - Correct phrasing of objectives is required to receive continuing education approval. Verbs to be ***avoid*** are: appreciate, know, learn, understand, and believe. Please refer to the [Developing Objectives Guide](#) for what is acceptable. Submissions using incorrect phrases will not be considered.
- Presenter Disclosure Statement*** - *EACH* presenter must download and complete a [Northeast Ohio Medical University Commercial Interest Disclosure Form](#)
- Curriculum Vitae or Resume*** - A one-page curriculum vitae or resumé is required for *EACH* presenter.
